How to reach the venue?

1. Take a flight/train/bus to Bratislava

Check available options within your budget.

Use low cost air companies websites or Skyscanner, Flixbus, etc.

2. Take a train/bus to Šaľa

The ticket price is 3,25 euro and it's 40 min travel. For trains within Slovakia please check: https://www.zssk.sk/en/

You can also buy a ticket at the train station (please, have some cash with you)

3. Walk 10 min to the venue from train/bus station



Do not worry!

You will be in a group of **6 people**, so you can organise a travel **all together**, it's always more **fun** ©

Travel limits

- Please plan accordingly, since we can only reimburse the expenses within your country's travel budget
- Keep the originals of your tickets and boarding passes if possible – it is required for reimbursement
- Before buying your tickets, please send us your travel
 option for confirmation
- Make sure you have a valid insurance (e.g. EU Blue Card) on the territory of Slovakia

Italy - 275€


Albania -275€

- The training room will be outside of the sleeping area,
