OBJECTIVES

THE ANTIDOTE TO HATE: Countering Radicalisation and Hate Speech" is a two-stage training course tackling comprehensively the topic of radicalisation of young people and hate speech, setting the stage for collaborative efforts of combating hate thoughts and speech that results to radicalisation and extremism.

For the **SECOND STAGE**:

- 1. Participants will have developed and enhanced their knowledge, skills and attitudes in countering extremist narratives;
- 2. Participants will be familiar with the combating hate speech and counter extremist narratives analysis, tools and techniques; extremist narratives and hate speech;
- 3. Participants will be familiar with developing, executing, controlling and evaluating counter extremist narratives and no hate speech campaigns.
- 4. Participants will produce materials to use as positive propaganda to counter hate speech and extremism, and promote cooperation and inclusion.



ERAMUS+ WILL COVER YOUR TRANSPORT, ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD. We will allocate ONE FREE DAY for participants to tour, hike, swim or just explore the island so bring some beach wear if you are interested to go for a day or night swim.






Temperature during the month of November is between 16-21 degrees, but it is still sunny.
