Objectives

The project's first main goal is to prevent and fight extremism and radicalisation through concrete measures within the local community. The objectives are to strengthen the role of youth organisations in countering violent extremism; and promote the role of intercultural dialogue and gender mainstreaming in countering extremism and radicalisation. At the end of the first training course:

- Participants will have developed and enhanced their knowledge, skills and attitudes in preventing extremist violence;
- Participants will be familiar with the conflict resolution and extremist violence prevention analysis, tools and techniques;
- Participants will have developed their capacities to apply and use intercultural dialogue in countering extremist violence and hate speech;
- Participant will be familiar with gender perspective and gender mainstreaming concepts in countering violent extremism and radicalisation.

You will surely spot some traditional outfits and hear their lively music (often played live in restaurants). There is even an entire art style called Zakopane Style, which is very prominent in the region – you will notice very characteristic buildings everywhere!

Where the 25th and 31st May are travelling days

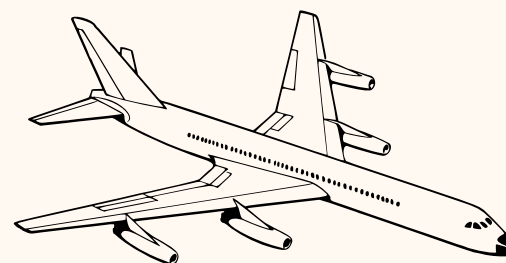
- 1 Day: Ice-break meeting

How to get there?



Arriving at Kraków Balice airport:

You should get to the central station from where you will get the bus organised

There is a shuttle bus or a shuttle train to Central Station from the airport.

Arriving at Warsaw Chopin Airport:

You should go to the central station and buy the train ticket to Cracow

There is a train shuttle or a bus number 175 to arrive from the airport to the Central Station

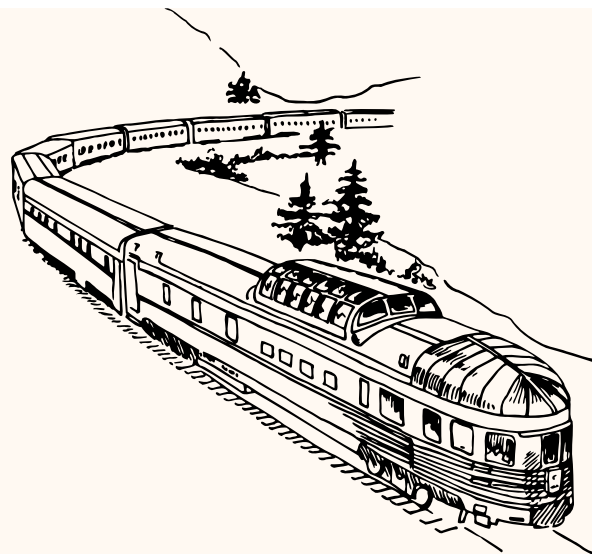
Arriving at Warsaw Modlin airport: You should go to the central station of Warsaw and buy the train ticket to Cracow.

From Modlin Airport there is a bus train shuttle to Warsaw Central Station which has courses every 30-45 minutes. The travel time from Airport to Warsaw Central Station takes around 50 minutes

AT CRACOW:

25TH MAY 2022 AT 19:00 YOU WILL HAVE A BUS SHUTTLE WAITING FOR YOU.

The bus will take you straight to venue.



Travel costs

Take into account that only the most economical transportation will be reimbursed

THE MAXIMUM REIMBURSEMENT IS ALLOWED:

GREECE, MALTA, UKRAINE, BULGARIA, SERBIA	TO 250 EUR
EGYPT, JORDAN, AZERBAIJAN, PALESTINE	TO 335 EUR
POLAND, SLOVAKIA	TO 155 EUR

The reimbursement has the maximum which is reduced with price for the shuttle organised from Cracow

We will ask for the following documentation for these methods of transport after the training course. So please make sure you collect of these:

- **Flight:** email with the price showing payment method (and invoice if possible) and Boarding pass (both ways)
- **Train/bus:** Ticket and, in case is possible, invoice too. Only cheapest option will be reimbursed

!PLEASE NOTE, WE DON'T REIMBURSE TAXI COSTS

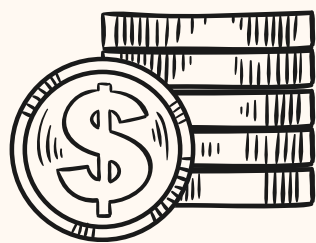
You will be asked to fill in a form with all your travel costs and add to the google drive together with required documents, so we can calculate how much you are entitled to be reimbursed.

You will be reimbursed once you send all the documents mentioned above. The money will be sent to the account of partner organisation in your country. After that you will be reimbursed to your bank account

Visa status:

Jordani, Azerbaijani oraz Egyptian participants may consult with us for visa extra bureaucratic and economic support if necessary.

Currency exchange



The currency used in Poland is PLN (polish zloty).

There's no exchange point close to the Villa. You need to exchange your cash before the flight or in the city of arrival or at Zakopane (at the airport for example).

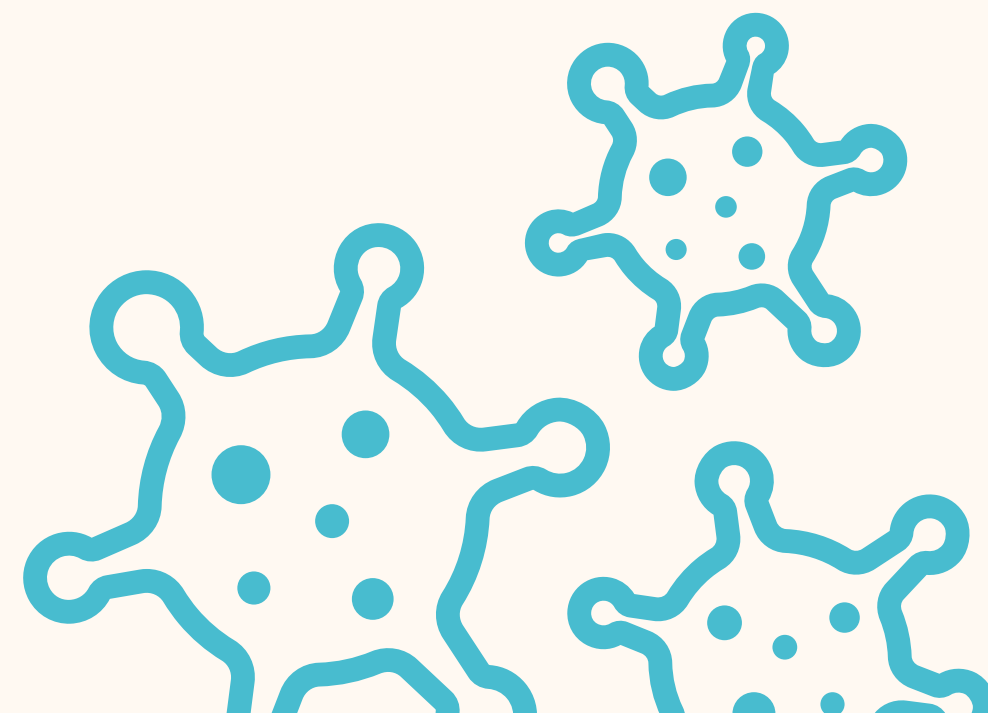
On the other hand, you can use your credit or debit card almost everywhere in Poland

Pandemic is still here

Make sure you have either COVID test (antigen or pcr) or you are fully vaccinated (to enter Poland without quarantine you need to to be made last shot vaccine earliest 9 months before)

Due to the duration of the Covid-19 outbreak, all safety measures will be maintained during the event in accordance with government regulations.

The organisers will adapt to the sanitary and epidemiological requirements in the case of further situation's development. During the event, participants will be obliged to obey all the rules of hygiene and safety
