About the project

01.

With this project, we want to reduce local unemployment levels and reduce unemployment in the local communities of partner organisations and follow the EU efforts. Hence the general goal of this project: is to create an encouraging environment in which students can use elements of non-formal education for personal and professional development to increase their chances of integration into the labour market.

Aims:

02.

- participants will explore and raise awareness of their values and qualities, which will help them make better decisions in choosing a specialisation at school, university and in professional development (the goal of the Europe 2020 strategy to increase access to young people in the academic environment and prevent early school leaving);
- at least five young people from marginalized groups (geographically, socially and economically) and 3 NEETs or more, to increase the employability of people with disabilities (social inclusion, special priority for young people);
- the majority of informal methods by which the activities proposed in the project will be realized strengthen freedom of expression, promote intercultural dialogue, the principles of active citizenship and the values of the EU and equality (horizontal priority).

Objectives:

1. Formulating the theoretical framework will make it easier for 42 participants from six countries to define the causes of the complex integration of young people into the market work and raise awareness of the possible risks of complex integration.
2. Strengthening practical and digital skills, which will provide better inclusion in modern workflows for a group of 42 participants.
3. Process support self-reflections and evaluations of individual abilities and potentials necessary for market integration work through 4 sessions that will bring together 42 participants from six countries within two days.
4. Development of social, civic and multicultural competencies necessary both for sustainable integration into the labour market and for promoting the values of the European Union to 42 participants using non-formal methods.
5. Application of acquired skills and attitudes that 42 project participants will achieve by designing and implementing educational visual and video content that they will share with the general public through social networks.

Why Zakopane?

Zakopane is a lovely town situated at the foothills of the majestic Tatra mountains. It has a population of 30,000 inhabitants. The unusual location of the town, hidden between a gentle range of Gubałówka and the rocky Tatra summits was a decisive factor in its career as a tourism centre.

Temperature in November varies from 0°C to 10°C so we recommend you to take warm clothes.

We want to organize a trip to Zakopane or Tatra mountains so make sure you've taken comfortable shoes and suitable clothes.

How can I get to Zakopane?



Before you buy tickets, all travel options **MUST** be consulted with your sending organisation in order to inform us about your plans.

We recommend you to book your flights to KRAKOW AIRPORT (Balice). It's the closest airport to Zakopane.

From there you can easily take a bus to Zakopane. We will help you find a suitable connection later on!

While arriving to the city centre of Zakopane you can take a city bus or a Taxi to drive you to the venue.

- Rooms: 2, 3, 4 people rooms with bathrooms. If you're fine with that we'll divide you to avoid problems. Of course, if you have any wishes, feel free to contact us. We're open!
- The training room is outside the sleeping area, within 30sec by walk.
- Each day, participants will be served 3 meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and 2 coffee breaks.

Travel info

All travel costs will be reimbursed based on invoices/tickets, boarding passes, and Reimbursement Sheet.

Approximately, each participant from:

- Poland shall receive max. 210 euro/person.
- Serbia - 320euro/person
- Bulgaria - 275 euro/person
- The Republic of North Macedonia - 275 euro/person
- Romania - 275 euro/person
- Czech Republic - 180 euro/person

Please remember that we can return only a determined amount of money so please, choose the cheapest ways of travel.

On the other hand, you can use your credit or debit card almost everywhere in Poland.

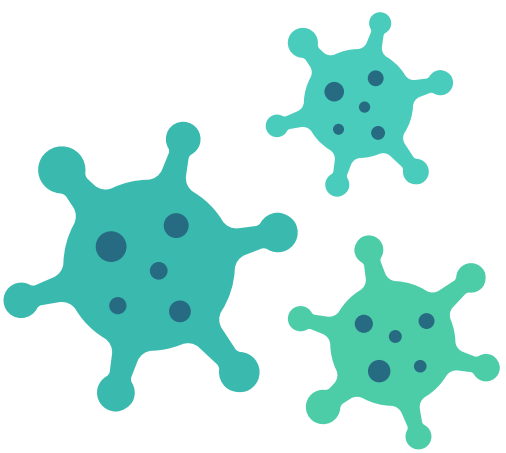
Covid-19 issues

The organisers will adapt to the sanitary and epidemiological requirements in the case of further situation's development.

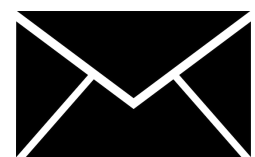
During the event, participants will be obliged to obey all the rules of hygiene and safety.

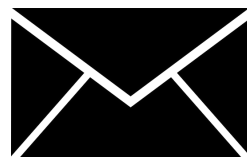
