



HOW TO GET TO VIDIN

- Transport to the project can be done by plane, train or bus. The day of arrival is 09.05.2022 before 14:00, and the day of departure is 1.05.
- For those of you who will arrive by plane at Sofia Airport.

 The time needed to get from Sofia Airport to the centre is approximately 18 minutes. Getting from Line 1 to Line 2 at Serdika Metro Station in less than half an hour you can reachfrom the airport to Central Bus Station Sofia and Central Railway station.
 - The time of departure from Sofia to Vidin with <u>Aleksiev transport</u> company is at 09:30; 12:30; 14:00; 15:00; 17:45. You can get to Vidin by any other company. There is also the option of travel from Sofia to Vidin by train.
 - And if Vidin is very close to a couple of cities in Serbia, there is no public transport between them, while transportation with cities in Romania exists, but very rarely a couple of times a week.


Participants can take up to 2 TOTAL extra days before and after mobility

IN ORDER TO GET REIMBURSEMENT:

Participants <u>need to have</u> all of their travelling tickets, invoices and boarding passes.

Participants must attend all sessions and workshops.



If you are travelling by private car, you can get the reimbursement only on the basis of the copy of the driving licence, documents that prove the vehicle ownership, fuel refuelling invoices with the travel date appropriate to the project dates.
